From Afghanistan to Zimbabwe, we were able to assist folks from 33 different countries in 2021. Though we didn't reach our fundraising goal, a total of 119 individuals still received an ECE® Aid fee waiver. Additionally, our Healthcare Response and Afghanistan Emergency Response were both implemented to assist with the U.S. healthcare system as well as the emergency situation that occurred in Afghanistan.
